ENLISTED AGENT POSITIONS (NON-AD AFOSI)

QUALIFICATIONS/ELIGIBILITY

AFOSI considers E4 – E6 applicants for retraining.

Note: E-7s may be considered on a case-by-case basis, but you may be required to accept a voluntary demotion to E-6 to be accepted for a position with AFOSI.

Required:

- Military experience
- Law enforcement experience/training
- Eligible for Reserves*

*If you are not eligible for the Air Force Reserves, AFOSI cannot offer you an IMA position.

Desired:

- CITP or agency equivalent (DEA, USPS, CID, and FBI Academy)
- Fraud-related experience (accounting, auditing)
- Technical surveillance countermeasures
- Forensics skills/training/experience
- Cyber skills/training/experience
- Digital forensics
- Foreign languages
- Diverse backgrounds (overseas experience, intel, etc.)

HOW TO APPLY

1. CAC-Users: visit the AFOSI Reserve Recruitment Portal listed on the main AFOSI website.
2. If you do not have a CAC or are having trouble accessing the portal, complete the application available on the website and email to AFOSI.Reserve.Recruiting@us.af.mil.

**If selected, final approval of any assignment to AFOSI is based on satisfactory results from the Agent Suitability Investigation (ASI) and can take up to 45 days.

REQUIRED TRAINING

If you are not an accredited AFOSI agent (or have been out of the program for 5 years) and are selected to join AFOSI's Reserve program, you will need to commit a significant amount of time in the 24 months following your gain date to complete initial and upgrade training.

CURRENT 1811s

If you are an 1811 and have completed CITP, DEA, USPS, CID, or the FBI Academy you will be required to complete several courses in support of your onboarding with AFOSI.

These courses will take approximately 48 days (non-consecutive) outside of your 12 ATs and 24 IDT periods. Your ATs and IDTs will be used to complete Career Field Education & Training Plan (CFETP)/On the Job Training (OJT) requirements.

FOR NON-1811s or 1811 WITHOUT CITP

If you are not an 1811 or an 1811 without FLETC's Criminal Investigator Training Program (CITP) (or equivalent course), you will be required to complete CITP and additional courses in support of your onboarding with AFOSI.

These courses will take approximately 200 days (non-consecutive) outside of your 12 ATs and 24 IDT periods. Your ATs and IDTs will be used to complete Career Field Education & Training Plan (CFETP)/On the Job Training (OJT) requirements.
